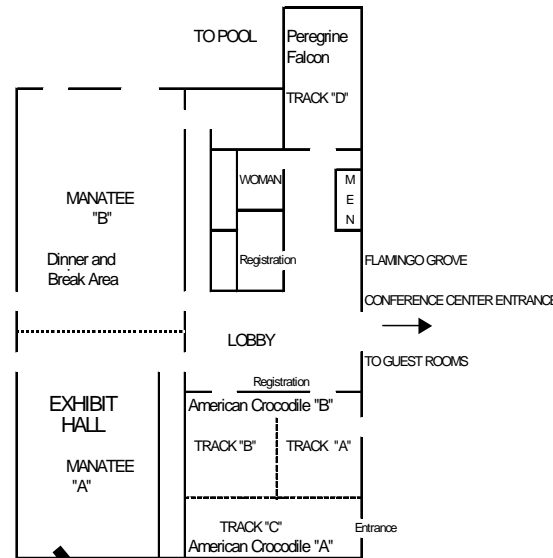

EXHIBITS FLOOR PLAN - MANATEE ROOM "A"

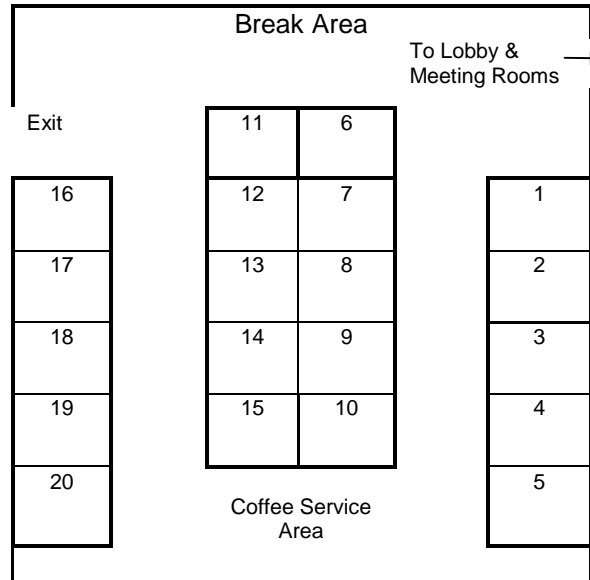

EXHIBIT TERMS and CONDITIONS

Exhibit Space

Displays and construction. A standard booth measures 8 feet by 10 feet and has an 8-foot backdrop of drapery on a pipe framework. Dividers separating booths are 3 feet high.

Displays must be constructed so as not to obstruct the general view or block any other exhibits, especially adjoining booths. If an exhibit structure includes sidewalls, they may be up to 8 feet high and extend 4 feet from the back wall. If an unusual design is anticipated, approval should be obtained from the conference management.

Character of the Exhibit. Management reserves the right to approve the character of any display and to prohibit any display because of noise or other objectionable features detracting from the conference. No exhibits may extend beyond the boundaries of the provided booth.

Restrictions on Use of Space

Exhibit booths must be staffed by at least one person any time the exhibit is open for viewing. Glaring lights, objectionable lighting effects, loud music or entertainment will not be permitted. All exhibit assembly and disassembly must be accomplished in the allotted time. These times are defined in the conference program.

Fire and Safety Regulations

No flammable materials prohibited by the City of Orlando or the State of Florida fire regulations may be used in any booth. Decorations such as crepe paper, etc., may not be used for decorations. Exhibitor may not run equipment that uses flammable chemicals, i.e., gas engines or other volatile compounds or mixtures.

Insurance and Public Liability

The conference staff and hotel staff, their management, and all individuals employed by them in connection with the conference are not responsible for injury or loss of property of exhibitors, their guest, invitees, employees, or agents or of personal injury and loss or damage to property resulting from negligence of exhibitor. Security will be on duty when the exhibit is closed, but the management, while taking all normal precautions against loss or liability, will not guaranty against such loss or liability. Insurance against loss or liability may be obtained at the exhibitor's expense from a broker.

Withdrawal

No withdrawal by exhibitor will be accepted by conference management unless written notice of such withdrawal has been received by conference management at least 60 days prior to the opening date of the conference. Any exhibitor who withdraws between four (4) to one (1) week prior to event shall forfeit and pay to Florida Log, as liquidated damages, a sum of money equal to seventy-five per cent (75%) of the full exhibit fee of said exhibitor's space. Any exhibitor who withdraws after one (1) week prior to event shall forfeit and pay to Florida Log, as liquidated damages, a sum of money equal to 100 per cent (100%) of the full exhibit fee of said exhibitor's space.
